## **Triangle United Soccer Personal Code of Conduct**

Youth sports play an important role in promoting the physical, social, and emotional development of children. It is essential for parents, coaches, and officials to encourage the values of good sportsmanship and lead by example in demonstrating fairness, respect, and cooperation of all parties involved.

With these values in mind, all members, employees, volunteers, and contractors acting as a representation of, or on behalf of, TUSA will adhere to the following:

- All participants (players, parents, coaches, officials, staff and other attendees) will be treated with respect regardless of race, creed, color, national origin, sex, sexual orientation, or ability.
- Any type of verbal or physical threats or abuse will not be tolerated.
- The use of profanity by all players, parents, coaches, officials, and staff is prohibited.
- All coaches, staff, and parents will have an attitude of positive reinforcement and encouragement rather than comparison and criticism.
- Deliberate unsportsmanlike behavior is strictly prohibited.
- No bullying of any kind will be tolerated from any player, parent, coach, official, or staff.
- The use or possession of alcohol or illegal drugs before or during TUSA events is prohibited.
- Smoking or the use of tobacco products at TUSA events is prohibited.
- Demands on players' time should not be so extensive as to interfere with academic goals or progress.
- Players will not be dropped off or at any time left unsupervised. Players should be escorted to practice and game fields instead of being dropped off in field parking lots.
- All players, coaches, officials, and parents will promote fair play and the highest standards of behavior.
- The health, well-being, safety, and enjoyment of each player will be placed above everything, including winning.
- Full cooperation with others in soccer (i.e. doctors, officials, physiotherapists, etc.) for each player's best interest will be expected by all.

I understand failure to adhere to the above Code of Conduct may result in my dismissal from TUSA or the privilege to attend TUSA events.
